BCFS is a faith-based non-profit organization founded in 1982 by several area churches. We are located in beautiful Northern Minnesota in the Bemidji Industrial Park and have developed a five-acre farm adjacent to our facility. In 2019 we became a SuperShelf, offering healthy choices in a bright, inviting atmosphere. With a staff of seven and hundreds of volunteers, we provide emergency food on a monthly basis for over 3000 area households. Overseen by a board of eleven directors, BCFS is currently in an excellent financial position.

About Northern Minnesota

Located four hours north of the Twin Cities, Bemidji lies in an area of lakes and forests dotted with small, vibrant communities and two federally recognized Tribal Nations – the original inhabitants of northern Minnesota. Bemidji State University and several other community and Tribal colleges attract music, arts and cultural events to the area. Bemidji is located near the headwaters of the Mississippi, which flows through Lake Irvine and Lake Bemidji. The forests and lakes support an abundance of wildlife. Recreation opportunities include watersports, snow sports, hunting, photography, fishing, and hiking and biking on an amazing trail system.
